Students take four core research methods modules (15 credits each), four optional modules, and write a 60 credit dissertation. Full-time students take all 8 taught modules Oct-July and submit their dissertation by 15 Sept. Part-time students take four taught modules each year and submit their dissertation by 15 Sept of their second year.


