

List of programmes with restrictions for students with criminal convictions

Programmes that require Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) checks:

- MSc Psychodynamic Counselling and Psychotherapy with Children and Adolescents - clinical placements require DBS checks.
- School of Psychological Sciences- any students undertaking projects which involve working with children require a DBS check.
- BA Psychological Studies (Child Development and Education)- DBS required by employer or school placement.
- BA Psychology for Education - DBS required by employer or school placement

Programmes that lead to a professional organisation/membership of a professional body

While most courses are open to those who hold a criminal conviction, before enrolling, we would advise that applicants consider potential barriers to professional accreditation, that they may wish to pursue after their degree.
